

# HOW MUCH WILL IT COST TO STUDY AT EMILY CARR UNIVERSITY?

The following is a budget estimation tool to help you predict your costs to study as an undergraduate student at Emily Carr University for the 2015/2016 academic year.

- Tuition, fees and dates subject to change annually. Prospective students should anticipate increased tuition and fees for the 2016/17 academic year.

## BASIC LIVING EXPENSES

This budget estimate is based on average costs. Vancouver is an expensive city to live in and costs can vary widely depending on if you are living on your own or in shared accommodations. The following estimates are very conservative so when you do your own budget, be sure to budget for your own circumstance.
