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ARE YOU READY TO GET SERIOUSLY CREATIVE?

The Summer Institute for Teens Returns with Two New Studios

This hugely popular month-long program takes place each July and provides an opportunity for teens, aged 15-18, to get a taste of full-time art school life.

Since its inception in 2003, the program has grown and evolved to offer ten distinct studios options. These include 3D Design, Digital Photography, Drawing (Creative Process or Illustration focus), Graphic Design, Graphic Novel, and Painting. And this year, Continuing Studies has introduced two brand-new studios – **Ceramics** and **Textile Forms**.

The Ceramics studio provides students with hands-on instruction - developing building, sculpting, moulding, and finishing techniques. Textile Forms will introduce fashionistas, sculptors and DIY designers to the machines, tools and techniques used for designing clothing, accessories and sculptures with soft materials, including fabric and leather.

In addition to studios, all students take part in Core Skills and Visual Culture classes, and participate in two class field trips. At the culmination of the program, students take part in a public exhibition, held in the University's Concourse Gallery. With expert instruction and small studio class sizes, students will discover and develop their talents, expand their creative abilities and critical concepts, and produce and document a body of work for their portfolios
