ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

Purpose:

The purpose of this agreement is to provide students at Vancouver Island School of Art, enrolled in the Certificate in Visual Arts, the opportunity to transfer into a Bachelor's degree at Emily Carr University of Art + Design.

Terms and Conditions:

Pre-admission Requirements

Vancouver Island School of Art students wishing to transfer to Emily Carr University following successful completion of the Certificate in Visual Arts (2010/2011 version) must meet the following English 12 and second language requirements:

- a) BC English 12 or First Peoples English 12 with a minimum C grade (or an equivalent) and;
- b) Applicants whose first language is not English must demonstrate their English language proficiency on an approved test.

Transfer to the Bachelor of Fine Arts, Bachelor of Media Arts and Bachelor of Design

Students who complete the Certificate in Visual Arts (2010/2011 version) at Vancouver Island School of Art with a cumulative grade point average of C (2.0) will be considered for admission into year two (2) of the Bachelor of Fine Arts, Bachelor of Media Arts or Bachelor of Design degree programs at Emily Carr University. Admission to these programs will be based on the applicant's academic standing and a portfolio assessment.

Credit Assignment and Deficiencies

Based on the VISA Certificate of Visual Arts (2010/2011 version) program students will receive a total of 24 Foundation Year credits. Students will receive 18 credits (block) of Foundation year studio and Foundation AHIS 102 (3) and AHIS 103 (3). Students will be deficient 6 credits of first year English (University Transfer). Students will need to complete these 6 credits either before their first semester at Emily Carr University or in their second year at Emily Carr University.

The specific terms, conditions and extension of this agreement will be reviewed annually by both parties.
