FORM 205.1 Course-Based Research Ethics Application

This application form is used for ethics review of course-based research activities that involve human participants. Note: If the participant research is part of the Faculty Member's own research project, use **FORM 201.1 Research Ethics Application** instead of this course-based application.

If course-based research falls within the **Parameters of Risk** described on this form (page 2), the application will be approved as soon as it is received and complete. The instructing Faculty Member will then be authorized to review the students' projects as long as the research activities fit within the **Parameters of Risk** and does not deviate from the research described in the approved application.

If the course instructor does not know the nature of all of the research activities at the time of the application (for instance, the students have yet to design their research activities), this application should reflect the most likely research activities. Later, when specifics are determined, the instructor should submit the amendments on **FORM 204.1 Request for Amendments** or use **FORM 205.2 Student Research Ethics Application** to communicate the changes to the ECU-REB.

To complete this application, include the following documents and send the package to ethics@ecuad.ca or deliver it to the Research Ethics mailbox. **Please do not ask the front desk or security staff to deliver ECU-REB or confidential materials.** A complete application will include:

- Course Syllabus,
- Class Roster (as available),
- Partner Agreements that pertain to the participant research (if available),
- Consent and Media Release Forms that will be used in the research, and
- Any other documents that pertain to the participant research activities.
