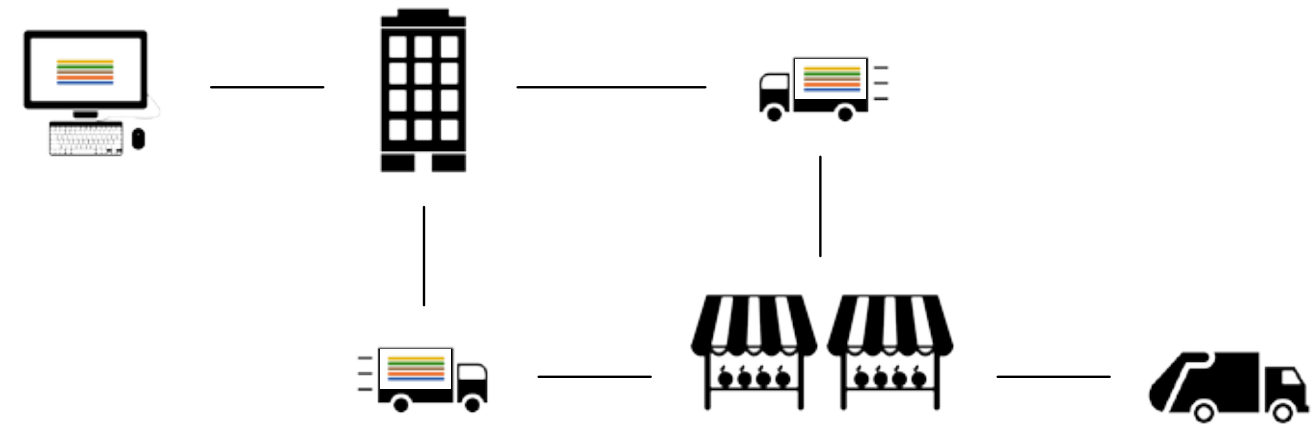


Metro Bin

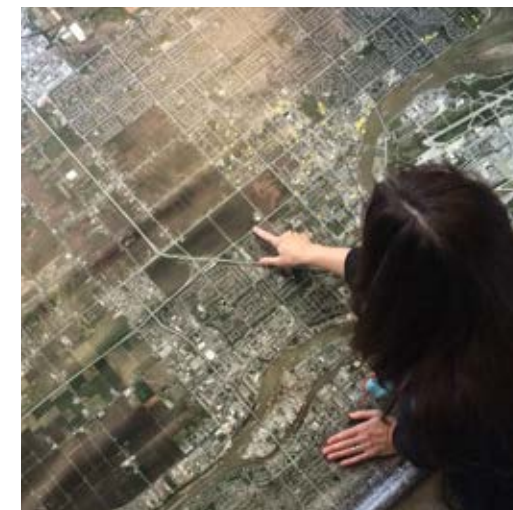


Alexandra Road Development | Public Art Plan
